5:30 Sectionals: **W**-Stretch/Visual technique/Music Warm-up, **B/FE**-Warm-up/Music, **G**-Stretch/Choreography  
6:00 Full Ensemble  
8:30 Move all equipment to band room/storage locations

## Friday, October 20, HOME GAME PERFORMANCE, SENIOR RECOGNITION NIGHT, Stadium Turf Field

- 2:30 CMB: All move equipment/props to stadium areas. **B/FE/W/G**-Set-up on turf right away  
2:45 Sectionals: **W**-Stretch/Visual technique/Music Warm-up, **B/P**-Warm-up/Music, **G**-Stretch/Choreography  
3:15 Full Ensemble (winds/battery; wear shakos and marching shoes)  
5:15 Move all equipment to band room/storage locations/eat/change into full uniform  
6:00 Non-competitive marching band students arrive in Members T-shirt/Members Jackets  
6:10 All Winds Meet in Auditorium/Band Room for warm-up and tuning/Battery Percussion meet outside roll-up door.  
6:30 All line-up in A-wing hallway (follow directors down to stadium)  
6:35 Set-up in stands  
6:45 Move to arcs on track  
6:50 Perform Fight Song as team runs out and Star Spangled Banner as announced  
6:55 Set-up in stands (no food or drinks, only water). Do not leave for any reason without permission from the directors. Stay in your section area the entire time and non-band students are not allowed to sit in our area  
7:00 Kick-off/Perform in stands for first half  
TBD On cue, competitive marching band students move to tennis courts. Non-competitive students sit together and watch over area. Some non-competitive students may be asked to help move pit percussion onto the field  
TBD Competitive marching band students perform at halftime  
TBD After half-time performance, competitive marching band students return to A-wing to change and return to stands to finish game/This is a not a break/All students must be back by the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter (in Members T-shirt)  
TBD After the game, return everything to band room and storage locations
